*\*This category does not attract an entry fee\**

**This category recognises an Individual. This award is provided to a person who is recognised as having promoted and supported the Inland Tourism Awards.**

Examples could include promoting the awards and encouraging entries, supporting operators in their submissions.

### *Criteria*

- Current Board Members of the Inland Tourism Awards, Judges, Mentors, Host Town personnel and contractors are ineligible to apply.
- This category is awarded by the board of the Inland Tourism Awards and as such, the winner of this award WILL NOT proceed to the NSW State Awards.

*Nominations must be made to through the Regional Tourism Organisation in your region. Please contact the secretariat with your nomination who will inform the RTO.*

### *Criteria*

- Current Board Members of the Inland Tourism Awards, Judges, Mentors, Host Town personnel and contractors are ineligible to apply.

*Nominations must be made to the Regional Tourism Organisation in your region.*

### *Important notes:*

- *The award will not be made to the same person twice.*
- *The answer to each question must not be more than 2 pages.*
- *The nominee's Curriculum Vitae and no more than 5 letters of recommendation may be included.*
- *This award will not necessarily be recognised annually.*
- *The criteria and rules for entry for the 2008 New South Wales Tourism Awards for Business Excellence DO NOT apply to this category.*

**The judges will take into account the following aspects of the contribution when assessing a nomination.**

1. Provide a brief overview of the nominee, highlighting their outstanding attributes. Include a brief history of their involvement in the industry including a description of their current employment, if applicable.
2. Provide examples of the nominee's personal service to the Inland Tourism Awards, over and above the nominee's paid employment..
3. Provide specific examples of activities resulting from the nominee's contribution that have significantly benefited The Inland Tourism Awards.
